## Transnational entrepreneurship in the digital area



- Migrant entrepreneurship: ethnic enclaves in the secondary LM (Waldinger 1993; Zhou 2004)
- Digital migrant businesses and differentiated embedding in the host society and LM (Hof 2022)
- Migrant entrepreneurs' subjective social mobility vs. precarity (Izaguirre and Sandoz 2023)
- The normalization and romanticization of IT-related flexible labor practices (Zhang 2023)
- Dissonance: institutionalized startups channels for foreigners and migrants' intentions (Hof 2024)



## Objective and argument: Unpacking 'skilled' transnational entrepreneurship



- Global competition for talents, innovation & foreign startups
- Institutionalization of startup entrepreneurship framed through skilled migration policies
  - What kind of migrant subjectivities are being crafted?





#### Methods & Data



- Field sites: Singapore and Japan as 'centres of innovation' and high-wage countries in Asia
- 71 highly-educated foreign entrepreneurs in Singapore and Japan
  - -Purposive sampling: multiethnic, multireligious, various nationalities, age 25-55
  - -University degree holders, a few previously on traditional expat assignments
  - -Various industries, esp. IT & AI, consulting, coaching/human resources
- Semi-structured interviews, ethnographic observations
- Online and offline field research
- Access to the field: Entrepreneur associations & networking events, SNS, personal networks


